Jurisdictions with Reciprocity

California

- California attorneys need a Missouri "Certificate of Attendance"

New York

- New York attorneys need a KS affidavit. Send this affidavit along with a copy of the course materials and program brochure.

Colorado

- Submit "Certificate of Attendance" provided by the sponsor along with a statement certifying that the CLE program is accredited in another mandatory CLE state.

Florida

- Attorneys must first submit a CLE Application for Course Attendance Credit.

New Jersey

- New Jersey attorneys who are taking courses approved for CLE by another state will receive 1:1 credit for courses approved in that jurisdiction through reciprocity

Attorney Application

Attorneys will need to apply for credit. Applications at registration.

Indiana - Application for attorney accreditation at registration. Submit with timed agenda.

Iowa – "Submit CLE Program" Online. Attach a digital copy of the times agenda (brochure).

North Carolina – Bar Member's Application for CLE credit. Submit with timed agenda.

Oklahoma - Uniform Application for Accreditation of CLE. Submit with timed agenda.

Ohio - Uniform Application for Accreditation of CLE. Submit with times agenda

Tennessee – Apply Online. Attach a digital copy of the timed agenda (brochure).

Texas – Application for Accreditation of CLE. Submit with timed agenda.

Virginia – Application for Accreditation. Submit with materials, timed agenda, and certificate of attendance.
